Explain procedure, speaking clearly, slowly, and directly, maintaining face-to-face contact whenever possible and don appropriate PPE		
Privacy is provided, if possible, with a curtain, screen, or door		
Before assisting to stand, patient is wearing non-skid shoes/footwear		
Before assisting to stand, bed/table/gurney is at a safe level		
Before assisting to stand, checks and/or locks bed/table/gurney wheels		
Before assisting to stand, patient is assisted to sitting position with feet flat on the floor		
Before assisting to stand, applies transfer belt securely at the waist over clothing/gown		
Before assisting to stand, provides instructions to enable patient to assist in standing including prearranged signal to alert client to begin standing		
Stands facing patient positioning self to ensure safety of candidate and patient during transfer. Counts to three (or says another prearranged signal) to alert patient to begin standing		
On signal, gradually assists client to stand by grasping transfer belt on both sides with an upward grasp (candidate's hands are in upward position), using legs and straight back, and maintaining stability of patient's legs by standing knee-to-knee or toe-to-toe with patient		
Walks slightly behind and to one side of patient for a distance of ten feet, while holding onto the belt		
Assists patient to bed/table/gurney and removes transfer belt		

Critical Failure Criteria

	Failure to complete within a five minute time limit
	Failure to take appropriate PPE precautions
	Contaminates equipment or site without appropriately correcting the situation
	Failure to manage the patient as a competent provider
	Exhibits unacceptable affect with patient or other personnel
	Uses or orders a dangerous or inappropriate intervention
