Contaminates equipment or site without appropriately correcting the situ Performs any improper technique resulting in the potential for uncontrol embolism		r, or air
Failure to successfully establish IV within 3 attempts during 6-minute times.	me limit	
Failure to properly dispose of blood-contaminated sharps immediately in	proper container at the point	of use
Failure to manage the natient as a competent provider
