Takes, or verbalizes, body substance isolation precautions		
Assembles the regulator to the tank		
Opens the tank		
Checks for leaks		
Checks tank pressure		
Attaches the nasal cannula to oxygen		
Prefills reservoir		
Adjust liter flow up to 6 liters per minute		
Applies the nasal cannula to the patient without discomfort to patient		
NOTE: Examiner asks candidate to stop oxygen administration		
Removes nasal cannula from patient's face		
Shuts off regulator		
Shuts off tank		
Relieves the pressure within the regulator		
Critical Failure Criteria		
Failure to safely and properly assemble equipment and flow oxygen		
Did not apply high concentration of oxygen		
Did not manage to administer oxygen within the 5-minute skill time	limit	
Failure to manage the patient as a competent healthcare provider		
Exhibits unacceptable affect with patient or other personnel		
Uses or orders a dangerous or inappropriate intervention		
Failure to complete bleeding control within 5 minutes
