Critical Failure Criteria		
Failure to immediately direct or take manual stabilization of the head	I	
Failure to properly apply appropriately sized cervical collar before or	rdering release of manual stabiliza	ntion
Released or ordered release of manual stabilization before it was mai	ntained mechanically	
Manipulated or moved the patient excessively causing potential spina	al compromise	
Head immobilized to the device before device sufficiently secured to	the torso	
Patient moves excessively up, down, left or right on the device		
Head immobilization allows for excessive movement		
Upon completion of immobilization, head is not in a neutral, in-line Failure to reassess motor, sensory and circulatory functions in each e device		nt to the

Failure to manage the patient as a competent healthcare provider Exhibits unacceptable affect with patient or other personnel



Uses or orders a dangerous or inappropriate intervention

Failure to complete spinal immobilization within 15 minutes
