Explains procedure to patient, if possible		
Takes Body Substance Isolation procedures and PPE		
Checks for allergies, contraindications, and incompatibilities prior to administration		
Checks Medication for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Correct Medication and dose • Solution Clarity • Concentration • Expiration Date 		
Remove safety cap from autoinjector		
Position injector in the middle of the lateral or anterior thigh		
With one fluid motion, strike the autoinjector into thigh muscle with enough force to activate injection device		
Hold autoinjector against the thigh long enough to administer medication (10 seconds)		
Quickly withdraw autoinjector		
Dispose of autoinjector into appropriate receptacle		
Obtain a full set of vital signs		
Monitor patient for adverse effects		
Monitor patient for desired effects		

Critical Failure Criteria	
	Failure to administer medication within 3 minutes
	Failure to take BSI precautions
	Failure to administer the correct drug, dose, or methodology
	Failure to dispose of needle properly
	Uses inappropriate affect with patient or examiner
	Uses or orders a dangerous or inappropriate intervention
